<i>BEREAVEMENT AND FACTORS OF ADJUSTMENT AMONG CHRISTIAN, JEWISH, AND MUSLIM BEREAVED PARENTS.</i>
A cross-sectional study was to examine the relationship among adjustment and other factors (spirituality, religiosity, perceived social support, and marital relationship) that might influence adjustment to bereavement among Christian, Jewish, and Muslim bereaved parents. A diverse group of 145 bereaved parents participated in this study, including 65 religious Christians (44.83%), 41 religious Jews (28.28%), and 39 religious Muslims (26.90%) with an average age of 44 (SD = 12.80). Results indicated that there were statistically significant differences between the three religious groups in terms of their adjustment, religiosity spirituality, perceived

social support, and marital relationship. These results shed light on some important implications for counselor educators and particularly for practitioners working with the bereaved parents' populations. Limitations and recommendations for further research are also suggested.
